INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL APPLICATION PACKET

Any team desiring to travel outside the United States must submit a properly completed International Travel Application Packet. Each form in the packet must be completed in its entirety. WSYSA will submit approved application to the USSF for their approval. On approval, USSF will return a copy of the approved application to the team coach or manager.

FORMS:

- Completed USSF Application for Foreign Travel (**Must be the Original No Faxes**) Incomplete applications will be returned and considered unprocessed.
- A copy of the official brochure, pamphlet, invitation or other applicable material of the Tournament or Games host.
- Two copies of the Official Travel Roster, which includes all players and team officials, signed and /or stamped by the appropriate Association Registrar.
- Any applicable US Soccer Federation fees as listed on the back of the Application for Travel.
Forms submitted without all applicable processing fees will be returned.
- The Ted Stevens Olympic and Amateur Sports Act signed compliance.

FEES:

- USSF Fees as listed on the back of the Application for Foreign Travel:

PLUS :

In accordance with USYS Policies WSYSA will process late applications and charge late fees as follows:

- \$20.00 if received less than thirty (30) days but more than fourteen (14) days prior to travel
- \$50.00 if received less than fourteen (14) days but more than seven (7) days prior to travel
- \$250.00 if received less than seven (7) but more than 48 hours prior to travel with approval from the Executive Director.
- \$50.00 to make a Roster change if received less than seven (7) but more than 48 hours prior to travel with approval from the Executive Director.

PROCEDURES FOR FOREIGN TRAVEL

No later than thirty (30) days prior to your departure date, submit to U.S. Soccer for approval:

1. a completed *Application for Foreign Travel* (must be the original - NO FAXES);
2. a copy of the official brochure, pamphlet, invitation or other applicable material of the Tournament or Games host;
3. A copy of the official *Roster* which includes all players and team officials, signed and/or stamped by the appropriate registrar;
4. check for the following travel processing fees;
 - a. \$50 (per team) made payable to U. S. Soccer.
5. the Ted Stevens Olympic and Amateur Sports Act signed compliance.

After approval, U.S. Soccer will forward the approved application to your team coach or manager. U.S. Soccer will then notify the national association in the country or countries to which your team is traveling indicating that your team is properly affiliated and has permission to travel.

NOTE

U.S. Soccer is not required to accept or approve any application submitted less than thirty (30) days in advance. Submit application form, required documents and fee to:

TED STEVENS OLYMPIC AND AMATEUR SPORTS ACT (TTED 3-03)

(As it Relates to Permission for Foreign Travel)

§220525. Granting sanctions for amateur athletic competitions

(a) PROMPT REVIEW AND DECISION.—For the sport that it governs, a national governing body promptly shall—

(1) review a request by an amateur sports organization or person for a sanction to hold an international amateur athletic competition in the United States or to sponsor United States amateur athletes to compete in international amateur athletic competition outside the United States;
and

(2) grant the sanction if—

(A) the national governing body does not decide by clear and convincing evidence that holding or sponsoring an international amateur athletic competition would be detrimental to the best interest of the sport; and

(B) the requirements of subsection (b) of this section are met

(b) REQUIREMENTS.—An amateur sports organization or person may be granted a sanction under this section only if the organization or person meets the following requirements—

(1) The organization or person must pay the national governing body any required sanctioning fee, if the fee is reasonable and nondiscriminatory.

(2) For a sanction to hold an international amateur athletic competition in the United States, the organization or person must—

(A) submit to the national governing body an audited or notarized financial report of similar events, if any, conducted by the organization or person; and

(B) demonstrate that the requirements of paragraph (4) of this subsection have been met.

(3) For a sanction to sponsor United States amateur athletes to compete in international amateur athletic competition outside the United States, the organization or person must—

(A) submit a report of the most recent trip to a foreign country, if any, that the organization or person sponsored for the purpose of having United States amateur athletes compete in international amateur athletic competition; and

(B) submit a letter from the appropriate entity that will hold the international amateur athletic competition certifying that the requirements of paragraph (4) of this subsection have been met.

(4) The requirements referred to in paragraphs (2) and (3) of this subsection are that—

(A) appropriate measures have been taken to protect the amateur status of athletes who will take part in the competition and to protect their eligibility to compete in amateur athletic competition;

(B) appropriate provision has been made for validation of any records established during the competition;

(C) due regard has been given to any international amateur athletic requirements specifically applicable to the competition;

(D) the competition will be conducted by qualified officials;

(E) proper medical supervision will be provided for athletes who will participate in the competition;
and

(F) proper safety precautions have been taken to protect the personal welfare of the athletes and spectators at the competition.
